Are you ready to rock and roll?

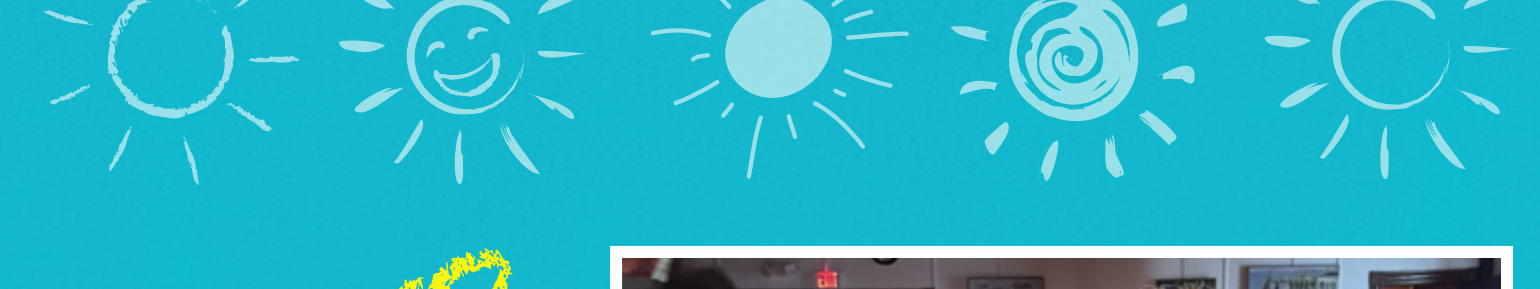

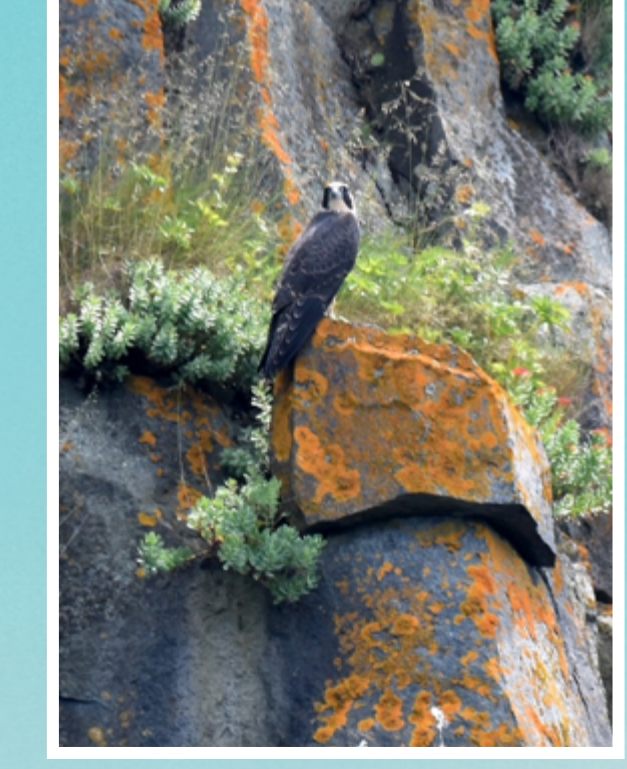
